Williamsburg century farms sought for history book

The “Williamsburg area” could be described as a) the area serviced by the Williamsburg School District, or b) Troy Township and a portion of the townships abutting Troy Township – The southeast corner of Sumner, The bottom 1/3 of Hilton, the southwest corner of Iowa, the eastern 1/3 of Pilot, the western 1/3 of York, the northeast corner of English, the top 1/3 of Filmore and the northwest corner of Greene. These are only examples.
